

Greshams' Gift Card Terms and Conditions

These Terms and Conditions apply to Greshams' Gift Cards and govern the relationship between Greshams ("we" or "us") and you or the person to whom you give the Greshams' Gift Card ("you"). Use of your Greshams' Gift Card will constitute acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

Purchasing your Greshams' Gift Card

Greshams' Gift Cards can be purchased at the premises (312 Tuddenham Road, Ipswich, IP4 3QJ). The minimum amount required to activate a card is £15.00. There is no maximum amount that may be put on your Gift Card. The Gift Card is issued by, and remains the property of Greshams, 312 Tuddenham Road, Ipswich, IP4 3QJ.

Using your Greshams Gift Card

You may redeem your Greshams' Gift Card at Greshams, 312 Tuddenham Road, Ipswich, IP4 3QJ. When you use your Card, the amount of your purchase will be deducted from the balance on the card (15% membership discount is not applicable when using your Greshams' Gift Card as payment). The remaining balance may be applied to future purchases. Change will not be given. You may check the balance on your Gift Card at Greshams, 312 Tuddenham Road, Ipswich, IP4 3QJ. You may not top up the balance on your Gift Card. Your Greshams' Gift Card is not a credit card, charge card or debit card. You may not exchange your Gift Card for cash. Refunds will not be given for the purchase of a Greshams' Gift Card. We reserve the right to refuse to accept damaged cards or cards which we believe may have been stolen or obtained in another illegal way.

Expiration and Cancellation

The balance on your Greshams' Gift Card will expire if the card is not used within 12 months of the date the Gift Card was purchased. We reserve the right to cancel your Greshams' Gift Card if we suspect it is being used fraudulently or in breach of these Terms and Conditions.

Loss, Theft, Damage

You should take care of your Greshams' Gift Card and treat it like cash. Greshams is not responsible for lost or stolen cards. You should immediately report any loss, theft, fraudulent or unauthorised use of your Greshams' Gift Card to the on duty staff. If you lose your Gift Card or it is stolen, damaged or malfunctions, we may, at our sole discretion, replace your Gresham's Gift Card and transfer the balance stored on it to a replacement card. We reserve the right to charge a replacement card fee for each replacement card. If you subsequently find or retrieve a Greshams' Gift Card which you have reported lost or stolen, you must notify the on duty staff immediately.

Resale/Use in Promotions

You may not sell your Greshams' Gift Card. Greshams reserves the right to cancel any Greshams' Gift Card that it suspects has been resold or obtained in connection with an unauthorised sales or promotional activity.

Data Protection and Privacy

We are committed to maintaining the security of your personal information in accordance with the requirements of the Data Protection Act and will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your personal data is kept secure against unauthorised access, loss, disclosure or destruction.

Liability of Greshams

Greshams will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from or in connection with your use of a Greshams' Gift Card where such loss or damage arises from any cause beyond our reasonable control. Where any loss or damage arises from a cause within our control, our liability to you shall not exceed a sum equal to the balance on your card as at the date that such loss or damage occurs. This clause shall not exclude or limit any liability that cannot be excluded or limited by law.

Variation

We reserve the right to amend or waive any provision of these Terms and Conditions from time to time or to terminate the Greshams' Gift Card service on reasonable notice.

Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions are governed by English law.
